GSR Report

Officers Reports

Treasurer's Report (Chris H) – Chris H. distributed and reviewed the treasurer's report and the group approved the report. Rent to the church was increased by \$50 to \$500/mo.

Corrections Report (Dennis N) – Dennis reported that of the 20 12 x 12's taken to Johnson County Adult Detention, only 4-5 were left 2 weeks later. Hal suggested they implement a check-out procedure. Old Business
