GSR Report

Frank (South Leawood GSR) reported on the District 10 meeting. The District has exceeded its prudent reserve by \$1,000 and will be in a position to distribute it back to the groups in January. We are encouraged to find ways in which to use some of that money (workshops, etc.).

Officers Reports

Treasurer's Report (Chris H) – Contributions are averaging over \$3,000/month. Around half of the cost of the Traditions workshop was covered by the raffle and donations. The Treasurer's report was approved.

Corrections Report (Dennis N) –Frank reported in Dennis' absence. Requirements for corrections opportunities are 1) must be an alcoholic, 2) must be sober at least one year, and 3) must be off paper for at least one year. Training schedule for Johnson County Adult Detention is Saturday, 11/17 from 9a-12. For the JoCo Juvenile Detention Center, training will be held on 2/6 – this is a Tuesday evening starting at 6:15p. This information is posted on the bulletin board.

Literature (Craig) – We received the literature Craig ordered, including Big Books, coins, pamphlets, directories, newcomer's packets, etc.

Treatment (Chris H) – Chris reported that we have begun to fulfill requests for rides to meetings in response to the mailings to nursing homes.

Cooperation with Professional Communities (James) – No report.

Public Information (Angela) – Nothing to report.

Central Office (Dennis M) – Dennis reported there are two new meetings - one in Buckner and the Keep it Simple group at 167th and Antioch. CO is holding its annual Christmas party 12/15. Dinner is at 6:00pm and a tree lighting ceremony will begin at 7:00. CO delegates are planning on visiting the groups.

Old Business

The group inventory committee is still in the process of organizing the event. It was decided the inventory would be held Saturday, 12/15 from 1-3pm.

The group guidelines committee continued working on a set of guidelines for the group. It was decided that the Service Structure Guidelines adopted by the Area and District will be customized for the group. Chris completed a rough draft and we will review and vote on adopting the guidelines at the December meeting.

New Business

Chris suggested we change from a personal checking account, for which it is difficult to change owners, to a business checking account. This will make it much easier to update when a new Treasurer is elected. Kevin recommended we require three signatures for checks over \$1,000. It was agreed that such checks be signed by the 1) Treasurer, 2) acting GSR, and 3) past GSR. Motions for both were made and passed.
